Feng Shui Consultation?

When is the best time to have a consultation? Let's think about it for a few moments. How are things going in your life? Are you generally healthy? How is your personal life with your family, friends and mate? Is your professional life and wealth up to your satisfaction? Most issues originate in one or more of these parts of your life. Without health it is difficult to enjoy your life. Without happy relationships your life will be less than it can be. After all money can't buy you real love. Of course money is important and makes the rest of your life more enjoyable. Do you have problems in any of these areas?

Each section of your house relates to parts of your body. If your house has problems or a sha (blocked energy) in the section that relates to your legs for instance, then you may have trouble with your legs too. The rotating energies of the year, month and day can join together in supportive or non supportive ways. When they meet they can create opportunities for legal problems, gossiping or relationship problems. They might also create opportunities for new romance or make it easier to get and keep money. Knowing more about your house and its surroundings can help you to explain past problems and more importantly help you avoid or diminish future conditions that are detrimental. You will also be better able to take advantage of locations in your home and the timing of good energies to advance your life's plan.

So if you have problems you would like to eliminate or improve, you should ***consider a feng shui consultation***. Your life might be going along well but you feel it could even be better, so you might consider a feng shui consultation.

What is the best time for a consultation?

Now!

Especially if you are starting a new building project. When you know what type of land to buy you can avoid many serious problems from the beginning. Maybe you already have land. ***Now*** is still the time. You will be able to make best use of the property and improve upon any conditions that are not optimum before you build. Oh, so you already have a building. ***Now*** is still the time. You can make the best use of what you have by employing ***feng shui*** to choose the best locations for your bedroom, office and other living spaces. Are you renovating? ***Now*** is the time to have a feng shui consultation to make sure you are not creating problems.

Now is the time to take advantage of a feng shui consultation to improve your life.

Exactly what is feng shui?

It is the art and science of how you are affected by your environment.

Where did it come from?

It is an ancient Chinese earth science that was developed over 5,000 years ago.

What do the words "feng shui" mean?

Literally, "feng" means "wind" and "shui" means water. It is an abbreviation for a whole concept: The energy which is dissipated by the wind collects at the boundary of water.

Is feng shui a belief system?

No, these principles are based on nature, laws of physics, common sense and good design.

What do the terms "good or bad feng shui" mean?

These terms have now become synonymous with balance and harmony, so a place that is determined to have bad feng shui is a place which can undermine a person's health and well-being. A place with **good feng shui** is considered an environment that **supports** and **enhances** a person's ability to do well physically, emotionally, and financially.

How is a feng shui analysis done?

There are a variety of styles and schools which have distinct methods for diagnosing a house or building. But all schools will take note of the immediate exterior influences and how they might interact with the interior of a structure. An example might be noticing the street alignment to a property, the shape of the building, and the particulars of the floor plan. An advanced analysis includes insight to the personality of the structure based on when it was built.

How long does a consultation take?

Depending on the size of the structure, the simplicity or complexity of the floor plan, and the number of occupants to be included, a consultation could take anywhere from several hours to several days.

When is the best time to utilize the services of a feng shui consultant?

One of the best times to get advice is before you **buy** or **build**. Houses with naturally good energy will generally bring more fortune than those that need lots of remedies to fix their flaws. Most people who are new to feng shui will receive a consultation for a property they already inhabit. There are still many powerful ways to enhance your property, even if it has some problems.

What are some examples of remedies?

Using natural elements in a room in a specific way can actually alter the energy of the room to the point where it makes a noticeable change in a person's life. Elements include water (like a fountain) and real metal objects, such as things made of copper, brass, or bronze. Other remedies may be employed in the landscape or furniture arrangement, as well as choices for color. Through interior design and décor alterations, the energy and flow of

air currents in a room can have an immediate or gradual affect.

The Bedroom:

- Sleep with the headboard or pillow side of bed against a solid wall.
- Sleep away from the entrance door to the room, not aligned with it directly.
- Avoid sleeping under exposed beams; use a canopy bed or create a false ceiling.
- Do not sleep under/near low windows.
- Cover big mirrors in the bedroom for sounder sleep.
- Avoid sleeping against a wall with electronics on the other side of the wall.
- Avoid sleeping against a wall with kitchen appliances directly on the other side.

The Office:

- In a commercial setting, place your desk so you have a direct or side view of the door.
- Do not sit directly aligned with the door.
- Sit in between overhead beams or unfinished ceilings that have air ducts or plumbing overhead.
- If the room is windowless, have pictures of landscapes to give depth to the space.
- If the room is windowless, have sufficient full spectrum lighting.
- Keep the room relatively organized and free of clutter.
- If the room is small with low ceilings, place the pictures higher on the wall to give the illusion of more space.
- If the ceilings are too high, place pictures on the wall lower so that it drops the line of sight down.
- If a structural pillar/column protrudes in your office, try to place something in front of the corner edge of the column to soften it, such as a plant. Making file cabinets flush with the corner edge can also help remove the "poison arrow" affect.
- Any bad views from a window should be blocked with plants, a partition screen or frosted windows.

Entrance:

- Maintain a bright, cheerful entrance. If it is dark, then you may need to keep a light on or do some remodeling to add a window or skylight.
- If there is a staircase directly aligned with the entrance, flank the stairs with a water fountain or a live plant to help slow down the direct path of chi.
- If there is a front door aligned directly with a back door, add a live plant or water feature in between those two points.
- If there is a direct view of the kitchen when entering, visually block it.
- If there is a direct view of a bathroom when entering, keep the door closed.

- If a wall is very close to the entrance, that feels halting, cover it with a mirror to create the visual illusion of more space.
